

COVID-19 Factsheet

What is expected from staff and students attending Campus during Term 1 of 2021?

Students and Staff are expected to:

- 1. Complete the <u>Safe Return to Campus training</u> prior to returning, or if you are already on campus
- 2. Stay home if they feel unwell, even with mild symptoms.
- 3. AVOID congregating outside Computer Labs and in building corridors and sit in designated seats in common areas to encourage physical distancing.
- 4. Wash/Sanitise their hands upon entry into the Computer Lab, and upon exit, even if this is done multiple times a day.
- 5. Wipe their desk area and equipment touchpoints before and after use and dispose of the used wipes in the bins provided.
- 6. ALWAYS maintain physical distancing within ANY building on campus, even if they wear a face mask.
- 7. Report any issues to their Supervisor as soon as possible.
- 8. Report any non-cooperative students to School Management for assistance
- 9. Get tested for COVID-19 if symptoms occur. This can be done at the UNSW Health Service.
- 10. Complete an online form <u>HERE</u> and inform your Academic Supervisor or the <u>Head of School</u>, as soon as possible, if your COVID-19 test is **POSITIVE**, as this is very important for the safety of others.

Students are expected to:

- Wear a mask in Computer Labs when you cannot maintain 1.5m distance from others. Signs on entrances will clearly mark spaces where masks are mandatory. DO NOT WEAR MASKS WITH A VALVE ON THE FRONT. Please watch this training video on HOW TO WEAR A MASK.
- 2. AVOID congregating outside Computer Labs and in building corridors, and only sit in designated seats in common areas to encourage physical distancing.

Demonstrators are expected to:

- Wear masks provided by the School in Computer Labs, where wearing a surgical or cloth mask is mandatory, and when you cannot maintain 1.5m distance from others. Signs on entrances will clearly mark spaces where masks are mandatory. DO NOT WEAR MASKS WITH A VALVE ON THE FRONT. Please watch this training video on HOW TO WEAR A MASK.
- 2. Ensure students are aware of what is expected of them, and that they comply with these requirements inside the Computer Labs, as per training.
- 3. Keep a record of students present in class/lab.
- 4. AVOID congregating outside Computer Labs and in building corridors and sit only in designated seats in common areas to encourage physical distancing.

Other staff are expected to:

1. Wear masks provided by the School in Computer Labs, where wearing a surgical or cloth mask is mandatory, and at other times (e.g. on public transport). Signs on entrances will clearly mark spaces where masks are mandatory. Please watch this training video on HOW TO WEAR A MASK.
